

About the Department

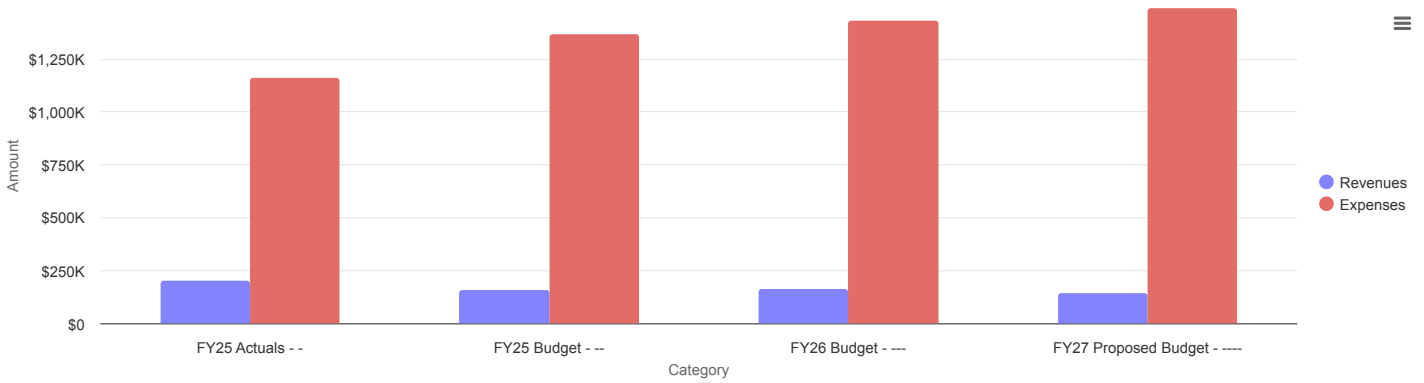

Programs

Animal Services works with Pocatello Compliance Department by housing stray animals and working to reunite them with their families as well as adopting out animals into new homes in our community. Yearly vaccine clinics and pet food banks are a few of the other services we currently provide. In the coming year there will be more opportunities for Humane Education programs for kids that will include reading programs, and critter camps that will allow children and opportunity to learn about proper animal care, responsible pet ownership and how Animal Services helps their community.
